

SINGLE AIRMEN

If you're a single Airman, you'll be housed in one of the 8 on-base dormitories or in an apartment offbase. Cannon AFB is the first USAF base to lease an entire apartment complex, Sendero Clovis Apartments, to act as an off-base dormitory. The dorms and apartments provide comfortable housing and improve the quality of life for single Airmen.



Cannon CDC offers care from 6 a.m.-6 p.m. for children 6 weeks to 5 years old. The center has the capacity of 158 children. It is accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children and enrolled in the USDA food program. Prices vary for the age and development of each child, ranging from \$234-\$931.67 a month, and includes the cost of meals.

The staff provides hands-on learning to attend to the specific needs of each child. The CDC uses the "Early Learning Matters" curriculum, which provides activities in these areas: social, emotional, physical, cognitive and communication skills.

The staff ensures the activities are developmentally appropriate for each child. The CDC uses the "Early Learning Matters" curriculum and sets goals for each child.

NM PreK is a free program offered during the school year for children ages 3 and 4. It focuses on creating a fun, rewarding, and developmentally appropriate learning environment. Teachers plan play-based activities and lessons that cater to children's physical, cognitive, language, and socialemotional development stages.

The NM PreK meets nine out of ten National Institutes of Early Education Research benchmarks for preschool quality, making New Mexico one of the only 7 states to achieve this.




